## Similasan Kid's Irritated Eye Relief



There are TWO Similasan Eye Drops that work well in dog's eyes.

One is this "Kid's Irritated Eye Relief" and the other is their "Allergy Eye" formulation. Both are quite effective at soothing pinkish, irritated eyes.

I've gotten this stuff at **Walgreen's**, and **Target** has it in the "contact lens care" section.

For <u>regular dogs with mild eye irritation</u> from say, pollen or groundlevel micropollution, ozone, or dryness. You would use this in one or both eyes anywhere from once, to three or four, times a day.

For dogs with an "ulcer" in the eye where steroids would be a hazard, Similasan can (sort of) reduce the redness pain and inflammation working in tandem with the *main* medications prescribed. Sometimes it's the ONLY thing that can safely reduce redness in an ulcerated eye. <u>NEVER</u> use Visine on a dog's eye.

If your dog has <u>"Dry Eye"</u> this medicine can be used once or twice a day ALONGSIDE some "Cyclosporine" or other immune-mediator. But neither Similasan nor Cyclosporine have antibacterial properties. You'll need to work with me

to figure out if an antibiotic would be good to use with these other meds.

DO NOT BOTHER USING THIS IN SQUINTY, PAINFUL EYES. Those dogs need to be seen in the office PRONTO.
