“Cannabis Therapy” Yeah, *that* stuff. It’s an oil that’s derived from Hemp Plants, **not** *Marijuana* Plants. It’s vastly popular nowadays and there are *ridiculous* claims being made (Dr. Oz) as to what it can do. But that doesn’t mean its snake oil. CBD is also nontoxic.

What can it do? FACT:

- **Skin diseases** especially wrecked feet and other allergies / inflammation
 - **Arthritis** and limberness
 - Behavioral issues with **anxiety**: Other dogs, strangers, leash walking, phobias, A.D.H.D.
- Reducing amounts of other **anti-epileptic** medicines and reduced incidence and severity of seizure.

There are **three absolutely essential** things that ensure success.

I. Get Real CBD:

The industry is full of **products that contain NO CBD**. Fact: Nothing they sell on Amazon.com has CBD in it. “Truth in packaging” is *nearly non-existent*. 70% of Hemp Oil contains NO CBD at all.

Leafly.com and Ravereviews.com showed people all the tested / trustworthy ones.

Due to their reviews, I use and recommend **www.CBDMD.com** and I recommend that **HUMAN product**. (Although the “Pet” version is fine, you have to *refrigerate* it.)

II. Use It Long Enough: Impatience is wrecking results.

2-3 weeks at twice a day for anxiety or behavioral adjustments.

4-6 weeks at twice a day for arthritic, epileptic, bowel and skin benefits.

III. Get The Right Kind & Route:

The “gummies” and “chews” are **ONLY** okay if you *have* to use them ☹ – stomach acid and a pass through the liver destroys a percentage of the CBD so ‘cheek absorption’ is preferred. So I recommend the **TINCTURE**.

Berry Flavor is well accepted. Some dogs will take it straight out of a bowl by itself. See video of Hobbs on website.

The dose a **dog** is supposed to get is 0.25 milligrams per pound of active CBD every 12 hours. **SHAKE WELL**

Cats should get up to 0.5 milligrams per pound of active CBD every 24 hours. Start at 0.25mg/lb once per day and go up. Lots of cats just get 5mg per day and it works fine. Tincture is far superior to “eating” it. **SHAKE WELL**

There are four strengths available at **www.CBDMD.com**

- 300mg/bottle = Cats (\$30)
- 750mg/bottle = Small dogs or to test the results on the short term (\$70)
- 1500mg/bottle = Economy in dogs up to 40 lbs (\$99)
- 3000mg/bottle = Only way to get several months’ economy in dogs over 60 lbs (\$149)
