

Conditioner Spray by Erik Johnson DVM

- Soothing to itchy skin
- Helps resolve dog <u>dandruff</u>
- "Bath in a bottle"
- Dry Skin Treatment
- Excellent and Inexpensive. Better than some medicine.

Fill a sprayer bottle with the following:



25% Pantene Pro-V Conditioner

(I tried a few different conditioners. *They are NOT the same*. For example Tre Semmes seemed too thick and oily for sprayers. So please just use Pantene Pro-V CONDITIONER (not shampoo)

50% Plain Water

25% Airspace above the mixture.

• The airspace is to allow concussion of the mixture to emulsify the conditioner and water. The mixture takes a minute to mix. It's not "just easy"

3 Ways to Use This Pantene Conditioner Spray

For Beautification/Better Scent/Healthier Coat:

Simply mist sparingly on the coat lightly and pat in.

For Dry Skin and Itching (Allergies, Atopy, Pruritis)

Spray on generously, rub into coat with hands, try and make skin contact as much as possible. <u>Use a dry washcloth</u> or hand towel to wipe some off, going WITH the lay of the hair to remove *about* half of what you've put on. Or think of it this way, you only want to remove enough so as to NOT stain your furniture. Pantene Pro-V Conditioner DOES absorb and dry off pretty well.

For Actual "Bath in a Bottle"

Spray on generously, and rub through the coat. Try and saturate (and tousle) the coat with your fingers like a scalp massage to lift dirt, dust, dandruff, etc. This will be DIFFICULT to impossible on long haired dogs. Then, <u>using a WET (just short of drippy) washcloth</u>, rub out the Conditioner Spray. Again, you're NOT trying to remove ALL of it.
